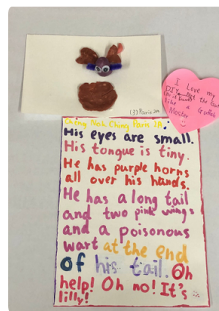




P.2
